

# What is it?

The EIFSmart Contractor is a recognition awarded to **companies** that are committed to quality workmanship in exterior insulation and finish systems. The company demonstrates its merit and commitment through EIFS education and certification. The recognition requires that a specified percentage of the employees have been educated in EIFS application and theory, according to industry standards and accepted means and methods of high-quality installations.

There is accountability to the distinction such as adhering to a Code of Ethics. This entails, among other things, that the company employ trained and tested personnel in the EIFS-Doing It Right methods. Only those who pass a rigorous examination earn the certification. These personal certifications are a requirement for the company recognition.

Point of Clarification. The EIFSmart
Contractor is a corporate credential.
Only companies can earn it.
People who pass the EIFS exam are certified.

# How is it done?

To earn the EIFSmart Contractor seal, the company's employees must be instructed and certified through the national, standardized program available from the Association of the Wall and Ceiling Industry. The educational content is based on ASTM C1397 and other standards and best practices. This content is approved by authorities from various sectors of the industry. The examination for the associated certification is developed and maintained by subject matter experts and testing professionals.

# Who recognizes the EIF Smart Contractor Seal?

This distinction has quickly found favor and recognition within various segments of the construction community. Because it is a helpful tool to identify the quality performers, an increasing number of architects, spec writers, general contractors, code bodies and insurance companies are requiring this seal. Based on the grassroots acceptance to date, the expectation is that the recognition and adoption of the EIFSmart Contractor seal will continue to increase.

# What are the requirements?

Companies wishing to become recognized as an EIFSmart Contractor must meet the following requirements:

- 40 percent of the EIFS employees must hold a valid certification from AWCI.
- ☐ This ratio is to be carried for each project.
- At least one of the certified employees must be at the decision-making or management level so that the message of "EIFS-Doing It Right" is adopted and directed from the top down.
- ☐ The foreman for each EIFS project is to be AWCI certified.
- An annual reporting form attests that the criteria are met on a continuing basis in order to maintain the distinction and be listed on the National Registry at www.awci.org/registry.

#### ■ EIFS Contractor

The EIFSmart Contractor seal easily identifies companies that are committed to quality. The list of EIFSmart Contractors is found at www.awci.org/registry. Holding the distinction allows companies to bid work requiring the seal, raises their business prospects and helps with insurance negotiations. It also better enables the contractor to attract and retain quality employees who are more productive when they learn why they follow the procedures explained during the education process.

# ■ General Contractor

Hiring an EIFSmart Contractor provides the GC with an increased confidence level in the caliber of work provided by the company. With a greater assurance of a correct installation, the GC may not feel the need to monitor the job as closely. He knows he will have skilled and knowledgeable installers on the job. # Building Owner
